

Western Nebraska APA Pool Leagues Summer 2009 Schedule of Fun!

Tournaments are for players listed on a Western Nebraska APA roster. All events require pre-registration. No walk-ins allowed. All information on this flyer is subject to change without notice and events are subject to cancellation without notice due to weather, illness and other unforeseen circumstances. There is no refund or transfer of entry fees unless tournament is cancelled by the APA. Large tournaments may go into the next day or even another weekend. Unless otherwise noted, we use a modified single elimination bracket (guaranteed to play at least twice). You will start out playing others at or near your skill level so everyone has a chance. We may run by tiers if we have enough players in each tier. In most cases, a drastically reduced race chart will be used to reduce sit time. Entry fees do not include quarters for the pool tables. Open to: Players listed on a 5 person 9-Ball team. Players must have 10 9-Ball matches played in the past two years. Winners must stay active through the Regional and National events.

Format: 9-Ball Singles Qualifier that will qualify 5 of 16 players for an upcoming Singles Regional tournament! We will run full handicapped races and double elimination. This will be bracketed by skill level so we qualify a variety of players. If we end up with fewer than 16 players, we will run the next best option.

Entry fee: Discounted to \$15! Normal entry fee is \$37.50 so you save BIG! Entry fee must include name of player and be postmarked no later than Friday, July 3rd.

Prizes: Winning players will advance to the next scheduled regional (no entry fee, may or may not be held in Western Nebraska) and play others in *your own skill level tier* for a trip to the \$350,000 National Singles Championships in Las Vegas in April which includes a \$200 travel allowance, \$200 guaranteed last place cash and prizes and paid lodging at the Riviera Hotel and Casino, site of the APA National Championships. At the APA National Championships, you will continue to play others in *your own skill level tier*. Open to: All APA players listed on any active APA roster.

Format: Singles, alternating between 8-Ball and 9-Ball. Start out playing others at or near your own skill level. Handicapped races. Skill levels are based on your current status on our standard 5 person teams. Those playing Masters only will play 8-Ball as a skill level 7 and 9-Ball as a skill level 9.

** If you are active in both 8-Ball and 9-Ball and have 20 scores in the past two years in each, you will play at your current skill level in each format.

** If you are active in 8-Ball but not 9-Ball and you have 20 matches played in 8-Ball in the past two years, you will play 8-Ball at your current skill level and you will play 9-Ball at your current 8-Ball skill level plus 1 or your past 9-Ball skill level, whichever is highest.

** If you are active in 9-Ball but not 8-Ball and you have 20 matches played in 9-Ball in the past two years, you will play 9-Ball at your current skill level and you will play 8-Ball at your current 9-Ball skill level plus 1 or your past 8-Ball skill level, whichever is highest.

** If you do not meet any of the criteria listed above, you will play 8-Ball as a skill level 7 and 9-Ball as a skill level 9.

Entry fee: \$5 per person. Entry fee must include name of player and be postmarked no later than Friday, July 17th. Entry fees will be donated to the Make-A-Wish Foundation.

Prizes: \$1,500 in cash paid to approximately the top 25% - 33% of the field.
