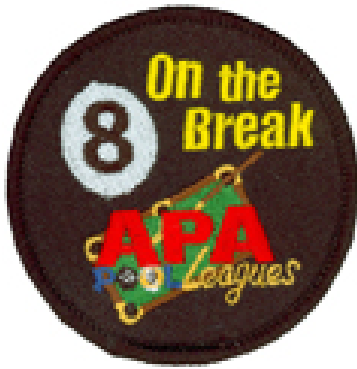


Western Nebraska APA 8-Ball League Awards

(Designs and awards are subject to change)



Team Captain – This patch is awarded to the team captain and is awarded at the beginning of each session to any captain that has not yet received this patch in a division. Team captain changes in mid session are excluded.



8-Ball on the Break – This patch is awarded to a player that gets an 8-Ball on the Break without fouling.



8-Ball Break and Run – This patch is awarded to a player that breaks the rack, runs all of his balls and legally pockets the 8-Ball without fouling all in one turn.



8-Ball Mini Slam – This patch is awarded to a player that accomplishes an 8-Ball on the Break and an 8-Ball Break and Run in one match.



Grand Slam – This patch is awarded to a player that accomplishes an 8-Ball Mini Slam and 9-Ball Mini Slam in the same session.



8-Ball Rackless Night – This patch is awarded to a player that does not have to rack the balls during a match, winning the lag and all games.



8-Ball "I Beat A 6" – This patch is awarded to a skill level 2 or 3 that plays and beats a skill level 6. Both players must have 20 8-Ball scores in the past 2 years.



8-Ball "I Beat A 7" – This patch is awarded to a skill level 2 or 3 that plays and beats a skill level 7. Both players must have 20 8-Ball scores in the past 2 years.



5-0 Clean Sweep – This patch is awarded to everyone on the team when the team wins all of their matches, going 5-0 for the night. All 5 matches must be played as forfeits do not count toward the 5-0 award.



Cash Prizes – Money is awarded to teams that finish in approximately the top 25% of the League at the end of regular session play. Here are some common paybacks for a 16 week session...

. 4 team divisions – 1st place wins \$350.

8 team divisions – 1st place wins \$400, 2nd wins \$270.

12 team divisions – 1st place wins \$495, 2nd wins \$300, 3rd wins \$195.

16 team divisions – 1st place wins \$525, 2nd wins \$395, 3rd wins \$260, 4th wins \$130.



Top Gun – This patch goes to the top male and top female shooter in all of Western Nebraska at the end of regular session play.



MVP – This patch goes to the top player in each of the 3 skill level tiers at the end of regular session play. Tiers are skill level 2-3, skill level 4-5 and skill level 6-7.



Singles Gift Certificate – This goes to each MVP award winner. Limit of one certificate per player per division. The certificate is good for free entry into a Singles Qualifier. This must be used the session after being earned and is non transferable.



SL 7 – This patch is awarded once per year to those who have earned APA's highest skill level ranking, skill level 7. Must have 10 8-Ball scores. APA picks one day per session to check on who is a skill level 7 and awards those particular players. In other words, if you are a skill level 7 for just a short time then you may not receive this award.



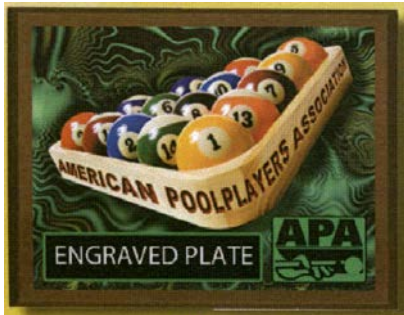
Certificate of Completion – This is presented to players that have played 500 8-Ball matches in the APA Pool League. It comes in a frame and is signed by the League Operators and APA President Renee` Lyle.



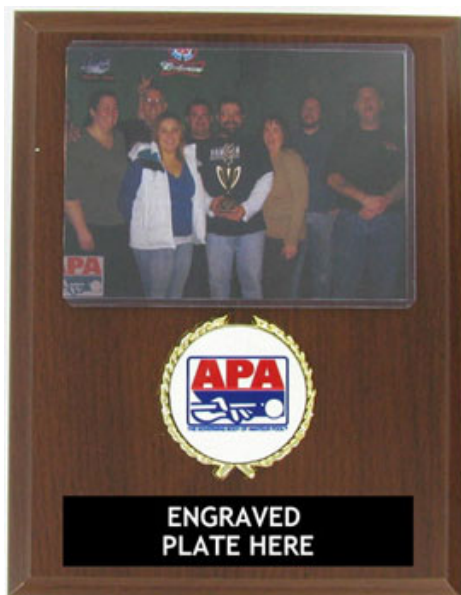
5 Star Sportsmanship Award – These patches go to each player of top rated teams in the category of sportsmanship at the end of regular session play.



Division Champions - These patches go to each player of the team that wins in the finals of the playoffs. There is a different patch for each session.



Division Champions (Individual) – Each player gets a choice of 5” x 7” plaques or a t-shirt. Players may get both for \$10. Shirt color changes each session and the design changes once each year.



Division Champions (Team) – This 9” x 12” plaque goes to the host location of the team that wins in the finals of the playoffs. A photo of the team will be placed on the plaque and is provided by APA.
